## **Breast Ultrasound - IMAGE PROTOCOL**

- 1. If scanning a palpable lump scan the lump in a radial plane
- 2. Scan the palpable lump in an antiradial plane.
- 3. If there is an area of concern seen on the mammogram, scan the area of interest in a radial and antiradial plane.
- 4. If there is an abnormality seen take pictures with and with out measurements.
- 5. Use color Doppler to prove if there is or is not blood flow going to or within the abnormality seem.
- 6. If there is no abnormality seen in areas of interest from the mammogram or the palpable findings, take representative pictures in both radial and antiradial planes.
- 7. Document your findings on the patient's worksheet.
- 8. Additional images may be taken to document any incidental findings or pathology.
- 9. Document descriptively any and all findings.
- 10. Illustrate any appropriate pathology on technologist worksheet.
